AFTER FRATIN. Christophe Fratin, born in Metz January 1, 1801 and died at Raincy August 17, 1864, is a French animal sculptor. Brown and golden patina proof ca. 1850 sun: terrace 37x18 cm Ht 41 cm Provenance: private collection The absence of signature is very frequent on the works of this artist following the numerous public sales organized between 1849 & 1864 without reproduction rights to compensate for its recurrent financial difficulties. It is therefore preferable that the bronze be anonymous and contemporary of the artist rather than posthumous to the dubious signature.
