Brascassat was born in Bordeaux and studied art in Paris underLouis Hersent at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris. He won secondplace in the Prix de Rome of 1825 with a picture of the Hunt ofMeleager

He went to Italy and painted a number of landscapes which wereexhibited between 1827 and 1835, but subsequently he devoted himselfmainly to animal-painting, in which his
