Large oil on canvas signed H.Callot *, representing a marine landscape with sailboats in a port certainly in Belgium, canvas presented at the Universal Exhibition in Ghent in 1913 **, in its original setting, early twentieth century. This oil is in good condition. It is signed lower right and has a label on the back of the Ghent exhibition of 1913. The frame is damaged. A note: a small hole in the canvas on the left side, some cracks, features visible on the canvas (slightly relaxed), accidents and lacks on the frame, look at the pictures. * Henri Callot (1875-1956): (Ecfr.). Pupil of Jules Lefebvre and Tony Robert-Fleury. Exhibited at the Salon des Artistes français until 1936; out-of-competition member; gold medal in 1920; From 1937 to 1940, he appeared at the Salon de la Nationale. His
