Student of Lalanne. He began at the salon of 1874. Associate of French artists since 1883; honorable mention of 1884, medal of third class in 1887, honorable mention in 1889. Chevalier of the legion of honor in 1895. The painting represents a farmyard where a group of women discuss while sewing, taking advantage of the sweetness of the end of day. There is on this table is very nice work on the color. The touch of painting is well in the air with an impressionist technique.
