Description

Beautiful crystal tumbler in travel case of green leather, lined inside chamois leather. The engraved decoration reminds us of the historical upheavals that marked Europe more than 200 years ago: Napoleon I, at the height of his power having dethroned the Bourbons of Spain, installed in place his brother Joseph, the King of Naples (1806-1808) who thus became King of Spain (1808-1813). This travel tumbler is a witness, a rather exciting find, more than two centuries are past, it is not common, not listed, it may be a unique piece .. Crystal cylindrical tumbler, the bottom and its first quarter cut of diamond spikes, above a rotating decoration, opposing the profiles of the two sovereign-brothers, intaglio hand engraved with diamond wheel, and symmetrical rotating decor offering: garlands, flags, genius of
