With on the reverse the engraved text of his wedding. Still with the original marble frames. All in original condition, not restored. signed: ROSKAM = Kasper Hendrik Roskam born: Harderwijk 8 juni 1818 died: Amsterdam 26 februari 1894 made for his wedding 18 february 1852. with Engelina Jager. Each relief engraved with text on the reverse.

Ik ben een Hollands boertje,

Translation:

I am a small Dutch farmer,
Cheerful and happy,
I have a nice bride,

at the reverse of the relief of the farmer's wife:

" De deugd in het hart
En een meijste in een d'arm
Her eerste maakt zalig
En 't tweede warm."

Werdt men beloond - maar nu niet hallef
Kasper Hendrik Roskam, geb: 18 Juny 1818
Getrouwd 18 Febr. 1852
Met Engelina Jager -'t is een goeye ziel

Translation:

The virtue in the hart,
And a girl in your arms,
The first will bless you,
The second warm.
During the time of the golden calf,
You were treated, but now not even half.
Kasper Hendrik Roskam, born: 18 June 1818
Married 18 Febr. 1852
With Engelina Jager - it is a good soul.

Interesting to see is that in the rim of the hat on
the relief of the man there is a lottery ticket. This
has a typical symbolic meaning that the man has

won the lottery.
