PIERRE GRISOT, (1911 - 1995) "At The Cafe"

An elegant painting of a young woman in a cafe by Pierre Grisot. Grisot was a French post-Impressionist artist who took his inspiration from the Parisian School of Art. He painted in a lively light hearted style that was all his own. Whether he was painting fashionable ladies of the day, nudes or flowers, his work was always full of color and life. One of the most enduring features of Grisot's work is his brilliant use of color and his coquettish renditions of the female form. He enrolled at the School of Decorative Arts in Paris. There he studied for one year before he began studies at the Ecole des Beaux Arts where he received a diploma as a drawing instructor. Grisot getting started with painting and
