This unpublished painting reflects all the characteristics of his immortalized painting. in her paintings the most beautiful ladies of Versailles In this painting, the noble lady is represented with a long sword and with the lit torch next to a lion. This is the typical allegory of the war adapted to his famous portraits Measurements canvas 70 x 83 old gilded frame 90 x 103 Excellent state of preservation
