

Large19th Century Louis XV Style Marquetry And Gilt-bronze Writing Table Or Bureau



Description

A magnificent 19th century Régence/Louis XV style writing table or bureau plat of serpentine form. The leather top writing surface banded by gilt bronze borders above a frieze with three shaped drawers on the front and matching blind drawers on the back. Raised on cabriole legs headed by acanthus cast mounts and foliate motifs which follow the outline of the leg to the feet, terminating in scrolling foliate sabots. The oak carcase with a marquetry of tulipwood and kingwood with fine banding framing the veneered panels. The overall design follows the work of one of the most important ebenist of the 18th century, Jacques Dubois (1694-1763). He is particularly noted for his bureau "Choiseul", part of the Louvre collection. His use of exuberant gilt bronze mounts, which mark a transition between
