RAAAAHHH! Let it annoy me! It is enough that because he has an amateur painter in the family for him to be given to "restored" the damaged works! And here is the result: the restorations are of course to be redone, which is not the most serious, but the signature, of which we can see some traces at the bottom left which was in red, fragile color, almost disappeared during cleaning. Throughout the 19th century, military painting was very successful, not only in the Salons, but also in bourgeois interiors which perhaps sought legitimacy by exhibiting feats of arms and portraits of soldiers to their visitors. Excellent artists have engaged in it, even made it a specialty, such as Ernest Meissonier, Paul Grolleron, Alphonse de Neuville or Edouard Detaille, these collaborating even for the
