Large shepherdess with flat back, in beech, richly molded and carved with flowers, hooks and "surroundings" in bat on the back, and in belt. Her arms, in a large whip, she rests on small arched feet.

Louis XV period.

This beautiful shepherdess is stamped JB CRESSON.

Perfect condition of wood, some traces of old gilding on the back.

Jean Baptiste CRESSON (1720-1781), comes from one of the most illustrious families of carpenters.

Received Master in 1741, it is illustrated, by very beautiful seats, mixing elegance and finesse of the sculptures. The file, by its shape and its decorative elements are an example. This talent,
