Description

They are effigies of maternity which represent Kaatleyoo, the mythical ancestor or the pestle statues of Poro, the DeblÃ© which sometimes reach monumental dimensions and which, preciously preserved in the enclosure of the Sacred Wood of Poro, the Sinzanga or SÃ©zing, protect insiders who are still vulnerable. The name "SÃ©noufo" is a Bambara term from Haut-Niger which can be translated as "language of the cultivators". It is an exogenous term to designate all these heterogeneous populations settled in this area and practicing agriculture.
