Strong symbolism: "Among all the characters of the Old Testament who appear in theoretical works ... King David occupies a central place. Author of many psalms, musician of the king at the court of Saul, he embodies both the divinely inspired biblical artist and illustrious king who knew how to give the Promised Land an imperial dimension ". "The rapprochement with the Apollonian harp-lyre accentuates the fact that in David's mastery of music is accompanied by the qualities of divine heroes, beauty, rhetorical ease and the ability to fight:" He knows how to play, and he is a valiant warrior. He is a handsome man and Yahweh is with him "(I Sam.
