Description

Italian work, re-edition of the 1980s. Pair of LC2 armchair model after Le Corbusier, from Italy re-edition of the 1980s. The only and authentic, a timeless model which has made the history of design by reaching the deserved status of world famous icon. Designed to allow conversation in complete comfort, this armchair was exhibited at the Salon d'Automne in Paris in 1929, embodying the archetype of modern furniture, understood by its authors as part of "household equipment". The independence between the metal structure and the cushions takes up the principles of rationalism, the separation between the parts following the logic of industrial production, with the classic architectural relationship between load-bearing cement structure and internal panels. The balance between form and function was born from an
