In the background, at the turn of this same hill, we notice another cart. Pierre Auguste Brunet-Houard (1829-1922) History painter, military subjects, genre scenes, animal, landscapes. Pupil of Thomas Couture, he worked in the entourage of the painters of Barbizon who did not fail to influence his way. He lived in Fontainebleau, loving to tour fairs, menageries, circuses, from which he brought back subjects, such as Bear showers, Saltimbanques on the way, He was also a painter of warlike subjects, including The Battle of Wagram, but he felt more comfortable in his familiar scenes and hunting with hounds.
