Magistral mirror in patinated white plaster drawn by Jean Boggio, designer born in 1963.

This prolific creator, whose playful universe recalls that of fairy tales, has collaborated with the greatest:

Hermès, Baccarat, Daum, Chopard, Les Emaux de Longwy, Saint-Louis ...

This mirror produced by the Maison "Les Héritiers" in 1993 is no longer manufactured today.

A farandole of characters, cat prince, clowns, princesses, king's madmen, entwine around the central mirror, evoking the world of Jean Cocteau.

This atypical piece was edited in gold, silver and white.

This last color is the rarest.
