



Transition Armchair, Stamped Ns Courtois



Description

Transition period armchair in carved and painted beechwood, stamped N.S. Courtois, French, 18th century...

With a large flat violin shaped backrest, curved and padded armrests that connect to the apron at the knees with a flourish, and a wide and deep seat. It stands on four straight, tapered and fluted legs. The crest and seat rails are decorated with beautiful neo-classical motif carvings of covered urns flanked by garland swags.

Finished in a soft gray paint, and newly upholstered in a tan and green silk by Tassinari & Chatel, with trimming by Houles.
