Description

Rare collector's pendulum, Empire period and gilded bronze with mercury, signed on the dial "Martin Æ Grenoble" watchmaker listed in Le Tardy, dictionary of French watchmakers.

Main symbol of Fortune decorated with a love standing on a stool, brandishing a ballot bearing the number "90". Supported by two renowned. the game wheel stylized by the mechanism known as the skeleton. Consisting of white enamel strapping and a spoke interior is formed of a torch, a quiver and two crossed arches. The exterior of the golden cylinder is fitted with cuffs. Large cornucopia pouring out louis d'or. Rectangular base with rounded sides decorated with friezes, decorated with palmettes and swans holding a snake in their beaks. In the center,
