PORTRAIT OF MOHAMMAD BEN ABD ALLAH DIT BOU_MUZA, BORN ABOUT 1822 DEATH AFTER 1879 IS AN ALGERIAN RESISTANT TO THE FRENCH COLONIZATION, HE IS THE HEAD OF THE GREAT ANTI-FRENCH INSURRECTION WHICH MAINLY KISSES THE DAHRA, THE VALLEY BETWEEN 1845 AND THE CHELARSIFE 1847. HE GOES APRIL 13, 1847 TO COLONEL SAINT_ARNAUD. WE FIND HIM IN PARIS WHERE HE IS A PENSIONER; HE ESCAPED FROM PARIS IN 1848, HE WAS TAKEN PRISON IN BREST AND RELEASED IN 1849 BY PRINCE LOUIS_NAPOLEON AND IN 1854 HE LEAVES FRANCE DEFINITELY AND COMMANDS A CORP OF BACHI_BOUZOUKS IN THE CAMPAIGN OF
