Very good condition, original coat of arms slightly erased and off-center

Ten-sided bowl decorated with plucked ribs is bordered by a mesh molding. Count's coat of arms in its center, gules with a gold chevron, accompanied by three annuli.

Hallmarks (under the wing): Load: a horseshoe with fleur-de-lis all crowned, Rouen, 1722-1726
