Listed by Galerie des Rosiers A wonderful French 19th century patinated bronze statue. The statue is raised by a rectangular ormolu base above a decorative ground designed base. Above is a beautiful half naked maiden draped in a wonderfully executed flowing fabric. The lovely maiden represents Venus asleep on a detailed tree trunk. She wears her hair in an updo her head is resting on her forearm. All original patina throughout. Lucas Madrassi was a French artist from Italian descent born on the 8th of June 1848 in Tricesimo. He studied at the famous Ecole de Beaux Arts de Paris and later joined the workshop of Carrier-Belleuse. His work was exposed at the fair of the society of French artists
