Description

William LAPARRA (1873-1920) is a Bordeaux painter of landscapes and portraits. He exhibited in numerous Salons and received the Prix de Rome in 1898.

William Laparra had a great career and a hundred of his works were acquired by national museums, including the Louvre and the Musée d'Orsay. In his work, the portrait occupies a preponderant place.

The painter loves women: he represents them in bust, or lingers only on their faces. Wallpaper is often used as a background. Common traits, they almost all wear a colorful turban (perhaps a sign of his passion for Spain).

Far from his landscapes and his historical painting, often dull and with rigorous features, his
