Description

Carved walnut chest from the early eighteenth century decorated with arches and plant motifs. it rests on four feet decorated with stylized lion paws. the facade and sides are decorated with architectural motifs decorated with arches and plant motifs of Renaissance inspiration. the frontage is cut out with a door on a third on the right closing with a key lock and allowing to discover 3 drawers. the sides of the drawers are worked as well as the interior part of the door. the top is made of a single walnut plank. when we open the lid we discover a large niche on the left corresponding to the inner two thirds and a small storage space above the part where the three drawers are. The inside of the trunk lid is also worked with
