His painting considers volumes through geometric shapes, developed in large touches of warm colors. Throughout his career, the work of Henry-Maurice d'Anty (1910/1998) gave free rein to an expressionist and incisive style. The pleasurable work of the material allows a flatness of the image to hatch on the surface of the canvas,
