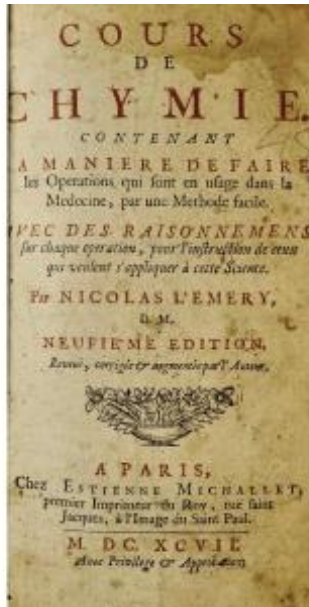

A renowned apothecary, he was also an eminent chemist. He is a Protestant and his life is interspersed with problems due to his faith. In 1686, he recanted Protestantism with his wife and
