



Large Bronze Bust Sculpture Oriental Ephebe In Turban By Luca Madrassi (1848-1919)



Description

Large bronze bust sculpture by the sculptor Luca Madrassi (1848-1919). Proof with brown and gilt patinas representing the bust of an elegant young oriental ephebe wearing a turban held right through by two medallions and a tunic decorated with plant motifs. Very beautiful brown and golden patina all resting on one foot. Signature on the side Luca Madrassi Paris.

Luca Madrassi, Italian, trained in sculpture in Rome then in Paris with Pierre-Jules Cavelier before joining the studio of Albert Ernest Carrier-Belleuse. He then became the avowed practitioner of Gustave Doré between 1876 and 1880. From 1879, Madrassi, through his allegorical subjects and his talent for composition, acquired notoriety at the Salon des
