Description

Entirely hand-knotted, pure wool, vegetable dyes, size: 290cmX190cm. Saraband rug is the trade name for Persian rugs woven in the mountainous region of Sar-e Band located south of Shahrestan of Arak and east of Borujerd. Located in this region, the locality of Malemir is at the origin of a neighboring trade name. The main motif used is the boteh miri, sometimes with a central diamond medallion, decorated with the boteh, and four spandrels which take up the motifs of the border, which is composed of narrow bands in different and alternating shades, decorated with the boteh or geometric motifs. . The background colors are varied: blue, pink red and ivory. Very fine carpet, double knots and extremely solid!
