René Roucoux (1923-1990) Originally from Brittany, he made his career in Paris. Trained as an architect, he turned to interior design and illustration. There are two axes in his work: a surrealist, dreamlike and sensual vein / a more decorative vein, intended for commissions. o A Surrealist Vein: at the end of the 1940s, he produced, among other things, illustration projects for Le Dîner de Têtes by Jacques Prévert. (n°1) - and other dreamlike projects. Throughout his career he produced illustrations mixed with eroticism, mythology,
