Huge copper pitcher, hammer-mounted, dovetailed, in the shape of a large bulbous pear, concave hammered underside, body decorated on centre of a prestigious coat of arms surmounted by a helmet: chevron, head of parrot on the left, and 2 diamonds, superb engraving and a repoussé finish. Above, on spout of pitcher, a slender bearded man sticks his tongue out at you.... Beautiful scrolls in engraving on both sides, lid also decorated.

Good dimensions, the pitcher should hold 5 litres. 31cm x 22cm x 30cm; weight: more than 3 Kilos Object of Alemanique culture, 17th century. For 350 years, it has undergone various interventions which have left scars, visible on my attentive photos: a consolidation below, worked in brass, a solder with tin at the very top of
