The adjoining tray is oval in shape, raised at the ends with foliage and festoons in relief. HARD porcelain White background with polychrome and gold decoration. On the body, a headband decorated with a garland of arabesques and floral foliage. Garlands of foliage and gold nets on the edges and on the body. The tray and the lid have the same decor.
