### Description

Beautiful watercolour signed by the painter Rupert Bunny. She certainly represents his wife Jeanne Morel whom he used to paint. This Japanese scene with a Japanese print on the left and a fan in the hands of his "eternal muse" plunges us into the intimacy of the painter and his wife. The angelic face of his wife, is not without reminding us of the prerafaelists' paintings of artists like Millais or Rossetti. The painter puts in evidence the face of his wife extremely ended, contrasting with the fault in part sketched. Watercolours, like Bunny's paintings, are very popular and rare on the market. His works are present in many museums and collections around the world. He is recognized as one of the greatest Australian painters. The watercolor is in very good condition, the colors
