


## Necker - From The Administration Of Finances Of France. 1785, Contemporary Binding.

He was appointed financial adviser to Louis XVI, but in fact, he will lead the institution where he will be appointed and will end up being appointed director general of finance, reforming the institution from top to bottom. He will conduct a bold economic policy. In 1781 he was replaced by Calonne. In 1788,

after the failure of Calonne, he was appointed Minister of State by the King. Necker will conduct a policy to prevent the export of grains which are lacking in France. The king dismisses him (this dismissal is one of the causes of July 14) and reappoints him in 1789, but Necker resigns in 1790. Good condition.
