Eugène Berthelon is a French painter born in 1829 in Paris. He learned painting from Eugène Lavieille and Etienne-Prosper Berne-Bellecour. He was fascinated by the Breton seaside and forest landscapes, which he immortalized with a precise and agile stroke. Berthelon uses soft colors such as gray or pink, under a clear sky, lightly lit by the sun or the moon.

He was 35 years old when he exhibited for the first time in 1864. These exhibitions made him successful and from 1881 to 1914 he presented
