Very pretty naturalistic composition featuring an overflowing cup of fruit, grapes with translucent grains, accompanied by a tart with raspberries on a silver tray, with a bottle with a handle in the background. Quality paint. Painting signed lower left Brunel Neuville. This work in good condition is presented in its large original frame in wood and gilded stucco. Alfred Arthur Brunel de Neuville is a French painter of animals, still lifes, flowers and fruits. He has exhibited in Paris, faithfully at the Salon of French Artists since 1879, Member since 1907.
