Description

A pair of romantic coastal views at sunset around Naples were executed by the listed French painter Sophie Vincent-Calbris (1822 Rouen - 1859 Lille).

She is the daughter of Michel Guillaume Concours Calbris and Marie Hulse. Pupil of Hippolyte Bellangé and Paul Renouard, she worked with Jean-Charles-Joseph Rémond. She sent her works to the Paris Salon from 1853 to 1857 and also exhibited in Bordeaux,

Boulogne-sur-Mer, Rouen and Cambrai, where she obtains a first class medal. During the same period, she worked at the Louvre and was responsible for copying paintings by masters. She moved to Lille in 1854 and established herself as a landscape painter. On September 27, 1855, she married Charles Vincent, head of division at the

prefecture of Lille, secretary of the historical commission and member of the French Society for the Conservation of Historic Monuments. pupil of Hippolyte Bellangé and Paul Renouard, she worked with Jean-Charles-Joseph Rémond. She sent her works to the Paris Salon from 1853 to 1857 and also exhibited in Bordeaux, Boulogne sur Mer. She died on February 6, 1859, rue Esquermoise in Lille following childbirth, after the birth of her only child, Carlos Émile vincent.
