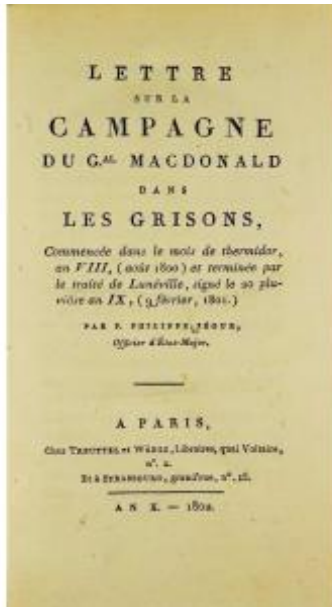

SÉGUR (Philippe-Paul) - Letter on General Macdonald's campaign in the Grisons, begun in the month of Thermidor, year VIII, (August 1800) and ended by the Treaty of Lunéville, signed on 20 Pluviôse (February 9, 1801) . Paris, Chez Truttel and Würtz, year X (1802); in-8, 120 pp. + 16-page bookseller's catalog, black half-shagreen binding, spine with 5 raised bands, a detached cover, provide for restoration. First edition of this text by the author who carried out this military campaign against the Austrians. Philippe de Ségur accompanied Napoleon during the Russian campaign. He published a History of Napoleon and the Grande Armée in 1812.
