




François Szulman, 1970s Painting Countryside Landscape, Autumn In Olivet.

SZULMAN (François), painter born in Paris on June 05, 1931 (Ec. Fr.). Just after the Second World War, he was admitted to the School of Applied Arts in Paris. He abandoned his artistic studies to help support his family but quickly returned to painting as a professional painter. This is how he exhibited at the Salon des Indépendants from 1951 then at other equally renowned salons such as the Salon d'Automne, the Painters Witnesses of their Times, the National of Fine Arts etc... His first exhibition personal took place in 1967 in Paris in the Régis Langlois gallery. It was a success and the enthusiasm for his painting continued to grow among amateurs and collectors. A painter of landscapes, he draws his themes from everyday life. His falsely naive style allowed him to stand
