French painter known for his still lifes and
portraits, particularly of beautiful young women.
He was a technical draftsman by training then
was received at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts under
the direction of the historical painter Isidore
Alexandre Augustin Pils. Ballavoine began at the
Salon of 1877, and exhibited at the Salon
