

Rare and important set pleasantly bound; complete with 10 volumes making it up. (The last two each contain two parts bound in the same volume). A few decrees (including the one announcing the promulgation of the Civil Code) have been bound at the end of several volumes. " Set up at the end of the Terror by the moderate republicans of the Thermidorian Convention, the regime reestablished the suffrage censitaire, which was used to elect the two legislative chambers, the Council of Five Hundred and the Council of Elders.
