Salome at the banquet of Herod A work from the Flemish school attributed to Frans Francken and his workshop (Antwerp 1581 - 1642), who likes to take up biblical themes and in particular the great banquets of History (the Feast of Balthazar, d 'Esther, d'Hérode, Lazare...) To be compared to the painting representing Esther's banquet that I also present to you on Proantic.

The account in the Gospel according to Mark, describes Herod holding a banquet for his high officials and military commanders, as well as high-ranking men from Galilee. During this banquet, Herod's daughter dances before him. He is happy about it and gives her everything she asks for in return.
