Beautiful, rather unusual object,
a Tibetan shell in the shape of a conch entirely
decorated with mosaics of color.
this type of shell often intended to serve as a
conch in Buddhist rituals in Tibet is here above
all decorative.
it is decorated with a very thick layer of mosaics
of turquoise, lapis lazuli and a red stone.
in the center stands out a compartmentalized
cartouche in the shape of a lotus flower.
each petal is decorated with Tibetan characters in
copper like cloisonné enamels but this time in
mosaics.
the rest of the compartments around the shell are
delimited by ornate silver threads.
on the perimeter these silver threads come to
receive cabochons of turquoise and red stone (it is
