Lovely working table entirely in blond walnut opening on the top by a flap provided in its center with a mirror framed by rods and discovering a substantial storage space. This flap closes with an original lock in working order accompanied by its key. In belt, this small piece of furniture has a large drawer also equipped with a patented lock from the WR brand, a guarantee of quality, in working order. Under this drawer, a crosspiece with a slightly molded cutout highlights the body of this piece of furniture. The whole of this worker is embellished with light strips on all sides and rests on four excessively arched feet in solid walnut with knockouts on the sides, carved with grooves at the top. In addition, a concave shelf connects the four legs to two thirds of the cabinet. Graceful and clever, this working table
