function remains to be identified ... Production  
from the beginning of the 20th century, with a  
pewter mark of the "knight" Louis Houzeaux with  
the hallmark LH and in the center the knight's  
helmet. Could be a syrup or alcohol dispenser in a  
bistro. The release of the taps is too short to  
imagine a use linked to absinthe... The  
manufacture of the pewters specific to Louis  
Houzeaux does not suggest a production  
dedicated to scientific instruments... The object is  
in good general condition, it there is no lid and a  
central part is missing for a single faucet. The  
glass parts show no damage. The column is  
straight. Note the exceptional level of mastery of

the glass blower who made the central column in one piece, the bubbles were not made one by one and then glued, the column is well integrated and in one piece.. You understood it well, this column can contain two perfectly separated liquids, with in its center a dosing system with 5 compartments. The main (external) liquid can therefore be water or a translucent alcohol, the liquid in the center must be colored, such as an alcohol or doses of opaque liquid sugar...
