Raymond Bigot worked as an apprentice sculptor with a cabinetmaker from Orbec, Father Hardouin, to whom he would dedicate a deep admiration all his life. He then took lessons at the School of Decorative Arts in Paris where he perfected his drawing and modeling. In 1911, he returned to Honfleur in his property named "La Hulotte", in homage to his favorite bird. Mobilized in 1914, he was appointed as a
