Fremiet is recognized as an excellent realistic animal sculptor ; all of his subjects are perfectly treated in a realistic manner , and depicted with an artistic truth and anatomical rigor that has not weakened over the years .Bronze signed "E.FREMIET" on the base.Antique sculpture , period second half of the 19th century .Very good condition of preservation and patina .Dimensions : 7.5 cm x 20.2 cm x 11 cmEmmanuel Fremiet (1824-1910)Emmanuel Fremiet is a French animal sculptor , born on December 6 , 1824 in Montrouge . Main representative of rationalist realism and even French naturalism of the second half of the 19th century .He entered the studio of

his uncle François Rude , after having attended evening classes . The fashionable theme of the "Confrontation between Man and Beast" inspired Emmanuel Fremiet and other artists . He was elected member of the Academy of Fine Arts in 1892. Emmanuel Fremiet succeeded Antoine-Louis Barye (1795-1875) as professor of animal drawing at the Museum of Natural History in Paris . He became the official sculptor of the third Republic . Emmanuel Fremiet died in Paris on September 10 , 1910 .
