Excellent condition, restored by our cabinetmaker, natural french polish. Marble, locks and bronzes are original. The frame is healthy and solid.

Son of the cabinetmaker Antoine Gosselin, Adrien-Antoine Gosselin obtained his master's degree in 1772 and moved to Versailles, rue Duplessis. He worked for the high aristocracy and received numerous orders from the royal furniture guard between 1785 and 1790, intended for the châteaux of Versailles and Saint-Cloud. His furniture, chests of drawers, secretaries, corner cupboards, in the Louis XVI style, are elegant, simple and beautifully made.
