Beautiful and elegant little in-between chest of drawers in rosewood, lemon tree and rosewood opening with two drawers with inverted curves. A marquetry in butterfly wings and cartridge characteristic of the decorative game of this cabinetmaker, provided with a very beautiful original mercury gilt bronze trim very finely chiseled. Its original marble top, also with Corbin beak, is a marble called royal red. Furniture from the Louis XV period, around 1760, of Parisian origin stamped Jean-Baptiste Detroulleau, jurande hallmark, 18th century. In perfect condition. Private collection, remained in the same family since its manufacture. Dimensions: h.87 cm x w.82 cm x d.47 cm. History: Jean-Baptiste Detroulleau was received Master on October 5, 1767. He settled in rue de Charonne, having left
