Rare travel writing desk, in blackened wood with brass inlays depicting a monogram in the center, surrounded by flowers, scrolls, arabesques and knots. This unusual object opens at the top thanks to an original hook lock, with its key in working order. The upper part lifts up and reveals three compartments forming a correspondence sorter. The opening of this storage space allows that of the writing desk part whose top is a cove. The interior, speckled with Thuya, is made up of small storage spaces and new leather with a golden patch, complete with a small tab. This pulls out to reveal a storage space underneath. In addition to the functional aspect, you will appreciate the rich ornamentation of this Napoleon III writing desk. A beautiful object that attracts attention and arouses curiosity. ******
