### Description

After Sir Anthony van Dyck (Flemish painter, 1599-1641), Group of three young girls with a bust of Mercury Oil on canvas (doubled), probably 18th century, with French wax seal (Paris) on the frame, presented in a beautiful golden frame.

This segment depicting three young girls is taken from Anton van Dyck's Portrait of a Family Group, now in the collection of the Detroit Institute of Arts. The original painting, uncertainly dated to 1635-1638, was in the collection of Sir Peter Lely in London in the late 17th century.

It then passed through several English collectors before being acquired by Albert Salomon de Rothschild in 1883.
