This central motif is completed on the side by a rich ornamentation of carvatids in gilded bronze, adding a classical architectural element to the design.Detailed Borders: The borders that run along the cabinet are all gilded and exquisitely engraved with beautiful patterns, further enhancing its luxurious appeal.
